



TRAINS

- Petersfield railway station serves the town at Petersfield, being one hour from London (Waterloo) and 30 minutes from Portsmouth Harbour by train.
- The town is also well connected to surrounding towns, proving an important passenger route

BUSES & COACHES

- Good links from Petersfield Station to Rams Walk. Journey times via bus and train can be viewed and planned [here](#)
- Some bus services, although limited, link the town with Winchester and Bishops Waltham to the west, Chichester, Havant and Waterlooville to the south, Midhurst to the east and Liss and Alton to the north

GETTING TO AND FROM THE STATION

WALKING


- Rams Walk is situated within the heart of Petersfield and is a short walk from most the high street providing ease of access to residents and visitors
- The majority of people living in Petersfield are within about 10 minutes' walk of the High Street.

DRIVING

- There are over 300 parking spaces available in Petersfield. The Central car park belongs to East Hampshire District Council and is the closest car park for Shopping at Waitrose.
- They will even refund 50p towards the cost of your parking on production of your parking ticket when you spend a minimum of £5 in Waitrose and park in a council run car park - See more [here](#)

CYCLIST & RUNNERS FACILITIES

- Rams Walk is well services by national cycle route 22, which passes within 50ms east of Rams Walk.
- This 64 mile route passes through Banstead (near Epsom) and Brockenhurst via Dorking, Guildford, Farnham, Petersfield, Havant, Portsmouth and the Isle of Wight between Ryde and Yarmouth.
- Many Local cycle routes also pass within the vicinity of Rams walk, enabling neighbouring towns to utilise this green mode of transport to see the full selection of local routes, please refer to the [Map My Ride](#) website.






TRAVEL INITIATIVES
